

DAY 101

LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.16, 2.17

CONTENT:

1. LEARNING TIME EXPRESSIONS (DAYS OF THE WEEK, WORKWEEK, WEEKDAYS, WEEKENDS, ETC.)
2. PRACTICE DESCRIBING A PERSON'S WEEKLY SCHEDULE

OVERVIEW: In lesson 2.17, the students are presented with a number of time-related expressions, such as the days of the week, the work week, week days, weekends, etc. They then take their knowledge of how to express time and, with the help of this new time-related vocabulary, describe one man's weekly routine with a view to doing the same in talking about their own.

ACTIVITIES:

1. Do a **REVIEW SEQUENCE** with the students regarding the daily routine verbs learned in Unit 2 (lesson 2.11).
2. Play the **LINE GAME** to review all of the verbs learned in Units 1 and 2.
3. Lead the students once again in **PRACTICING THE TESTS** found at the end of lesson 2.16 in preparation for the test to be taken in the next class.
4. Show the students the **INSTRUCTIONAL VIDEO** found at the beginning of lesson 2.17.
