LESSONS COVERED: UNIT 2 TEST – PART 2

CONTENT:

1. QUESTION RESPONSE

OVERVIEW: In Part 2 of the test, the students are given a reasonable (teacher's discretion) period of time during which to respond in a complete sentence to each of eleven questions about their life.

After having been tested, the students are to turn immediately to their preparation for part 3 of the test that will deal with responding to questions about their own life.

ACTIVITIES:

- **1.** ONE-ON-ONE TESTING regarding part 2 of the Unit 2 Test
- **2. INDEPENDENT STUDY ON COMPUTERS** regarding part 3 of the Unit 2 Test.
- **3. RESPOND TO QUESTIONS** if time remains following completion of the one-on-one testing.
- **4. PRACTICE THE TEST** found in part 3 of the Unit 2 In Part 4 of the test, students are given three minutes within which to convey as much information as possible about their life. They are shown a series of images in Part 4 which serve to remind them of topics about which they should be able to speak. These images should be visible to them throughout the duration of their entire talk. They are not obliged to speak about each topic suggested by the images, nor even in the order in which those images are placed. All that matters is that they communicate as much information possible within the three minute time limit.
