LESSONS COVERED: UNIT 1 TEST – PART 2

CONTENT:

- 1. LISTENING COMPREHENSION (EVALUATION)
- 2. QUESTION RESPONSE (PREPARATION)

OVERVIEW: In Part 2 of the test, students are to listen to a selection, accessed by clicking on the mouse at the top of each form of the test, in which an individual describes his or her life. Students may take notes concerning the content of the person's remarks. Next, they respond in complete sentences to the questions the teacher asks them about the selection they have heard. (See the grading key by clicking on the percent symbol found at the upper right of the page containing the test.) The teacher should NOT display the questions for the students to see in order to isolate and exclusively evaluate the skill of listening.

To expedite the evaluation of a number of students in a short period of time, and yet to maintain the integrity of the testing situation, while they take notes, play one listening selection for the first quarter of the students to be tested. Do not allow them to confer regarding their notes and then test them individually in a manner which will not allow the others to hear the content of the questions.

ACTIVITIES:

- **1. ONE-ON-ONE TESTING** regarding part 2 of the Unit 1 Test
- **2. INDEPENDENT STUDY ON COMPUTERS** regarding the next part of the Unit 1 Test.
- **3. RESPOND TO QUESTIONS** if time remains following completion of the one-on-one testing.
- **4. PRACTICE THE TEST** found in part 3 of the Unit 1 Test.
