

DAY 86

LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.2, 2.4

CONTENT:

1. PHONICS 1

OVERVIEW: Lesson 2.4 involves learning the language's phonics system with particular emphasis given to a second vowel. The first two vowels studied are highlighted in the readings found in lesson 2.4 – either regarding the Richardson family, the Creation account in Genesis or both.

ACTIVITIES:

1. Perform [ONE-ON-ONE TESTING](#) on the test found at the end of lesson 2.2.
2. Play the [SPELLING GAME](#) with your students to reinforce the alphabet.
3. [READ](#) with the students through the entire lesson 2.4 however, when you come to the actual reading selection in section 6, do NOT ask the students to read it aloud. First, point to the highlighted syllables in each sentence and have the students try to produce their sound. Then either click on the mouse to play the entire sentence for them or read it to them yourself. Click on [PHONICS INSTRUCTION](#) for further explanation.
4. Have the students engage in [INDEPENDENT STUDY](#) and direct them to study exclusively the reading in part 6. If work stations are not available, do the [READING](#) with the students, but click on the highlighted syllables and on the symbol of the mouse at the beginning of each section so that they get the idea as to how to use the lesson once they are able to study it independently somewhere where they have individual access to the Internet.
5. Perform the [ORAL PARTICIPATION](#) activity found at the end of lesson 2.4. You can either have the students retell the story from the images found there, or tell it to them yourself, inserting errors that the students must catch, or make a statement about one of the images for which the students must form a question that would receive that statement as its answer.
