LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.7

CONTENT:

1. PHONICS 5

OVERVIEW: Lesson 2.7 involves learning the language's phonics system with particular emphasis given to a fifth vowel. The first five vowels studied are highlighted in the readings found in lesson 2.7 – either regarding the Richardson family, the Creation account in Genesis or both.

ACTIVITIES:

1. Play the [SPELLING GAME](#) with words from section 1 of this lesson.
2. [READ](#) with the students through the remaining sections of lesson 2.7 however, when you come to the actual reading selection in section 6, do NOT ask the students to read it aloud. First, point to the highlighted syllables in each sentence and have the students try to produce their sound. Then either click on the mouse to play the entire sentence for them or read it to them yourself. Click on [PHONICS INSTRUCTION](#) for further explanation.
3. Have the students engage in [INDEPENDENT STUDY](#) and direct them to review the reading in part 7.
4. Perform the [ORAL PARTICIPATION](#) activity found at the end of lesson 2.7. You can either have the students retell the story from the images found there, or tell it to them yourself, inserting errors that the students must catch, or make a statement about one of the images for which the students must form a question that would receive that statement as its answer.
