LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.9

CONTENT:

1. READING SELECTION NO. 1

OVERVIEW: Lesson 2.9 presents the entire first reading selection exclusively in oral fashion. It concludes with an oral summary in which the students will have three minutes in which to summarize a portion of the reading.

ACTIVITIES:

1. **PRACTICE THE ALPHABET** by having the students work in pairs. They are to consult the Unit 1 lexicon and then to try to spell one of its words to their partners as rapidly as they can. The partner then must try to discern which word it was that was being spelled to him or her.
2. Allow the students to engage in **INDEPENDENT STUDY** so that they may listen to the description of the reading found in lesson 2.9.
3. Conduct a **PRACTICE TEST** regarding the two-minute oral summary to be done in the next class and whose images are found at the end of lesson 2.9.
 - a. Time the students as they give the talk to the partner with whom they were paired in the first activity above. Give time for both students to give a two-minute practice summary.
 - b. Select volunteers who say their summary before the whole class, thus allowing the other students to watch how you score such an oral presentation. Allow the volunteers to keep the score they receive as their actual test score if they are satisfied with it.
