LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 3.11

CONTENT: 1. PHONICS REVIEW

OVERVIEW: Lesson 3.11 review phonics once again in preparation for the final reading assignment of the first year program found in the next lesson.

ACTIVITIES:

- 1.** In each of the first seven sections, show the students the [VIDEO](#) focusing on one or more of the vowel sounds. Have the students pronounce aloud each of the syllables or words in the video **BEFORE** hearing it read by the instructor. Then click on the images of the mouse under each video and have the students select the proper transcription of the word they hear.
- 2.** [READ](#) through each of the preliminary sounds in section 8 with the students and then have one of the class members try to pronounce the final word in the line. If they pronounce it incorrectly, have the class go back and pronounce the specific syllable or letter on that line that the student had pronounced incorrectly and then have the student try again.
- 3.** In the final section, first read one of the selections to the students using the phonics system of their native language. As they are not accustomed to hearing such an accent coming from your mouth, this will emphasize to the students how atrocious is the result of not attempting to replicate the sounds of the proper phonics system. Next, click on the mouse to hear the selection read again. Then, reread it correctly yourself, emphasizing the physiological elements that go into employing proper pronunciation in the target language. Finally, have the students read portions of the selection, stopping them after incorrect pronunciation and insisting they make an effort to pronounce correctly.
