DAY 58

LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 1.39, 1.41

CONTENT:

- 1. TEST ON 60 MOST COMMON VERBS (1.39)
- 2. REVIEW ALL NUMBERS 1-69
- 3. PRESENT NUMBERS 70-100

OVERVIEW: In this lesson, after taking the 1.39 test on the 60 most common verbs, in lesson 1.41, the students will review their knowledge of numbers from 1 to 69 and then will be presented with numbers 70 to 100. Lesson 1.41 involves the first dictation, though it will not involve writing words, but simply digits. In the fifth section of the lesson, the students will click on a numbered button, which links to sound files in which they will hear a dictation of a series of numbers, 1 to 100. The students will then write or type the numbers in a separate document. Once the series of numbers has been written down, they will be able to click on the image of a mouse that links to the correct transcription of those numbers.

ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Conduct the **ONE-ON-ONE TEST** found in lesson 1.39.
- 2. During the test, the students should engage in a **LANGUAGE PALS SESSION** with their correspondent, using the questions found in lesson 1.39.
- 3. Following the test, conduct a **<u>DEBRIEFING SESSION</u>** with the students regarding their Language Pals conversation.
- 4. **READ** through lesson 1.41, first alone and then with the students.
- 5. Play "SHOWDOWN" with the students in the third section of the lesson.
- 6. Play the "**DICTATION GAME**" with the students over the fifth section of the lesson.
