DAY 81

LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 1.50

CONTENT:

- 1. LANGUAGE PALS PREPARATION (VIDEO)
- 2. LANGUAGE PALS SESSION

OVERVIEW: Lesson 1.50 begins with a video simulating a Language Pals session as the ULAT instructor asks students questions taken from the content of Unit 1 and then, after pausing for their response, leads them to ask him the same questions to which he then responds. This video is intended to prepare students who will have to form the same questions of their actual Language Pal. The Language Pal is hopefully a student overseas who is a native speaker of the language being learned and who similarly wants to learn English, however the same activity can be performed with a local native speaker or even, if no one else is available, with the instructor. After the Language Pals session concludes, students debrief by sharing the information they learned with classmates and with their teacher.

ACTIVITIES:

- **1.** <u>WATCH THE INSTRUCTIONAL VIDEO</u> at the beginning of lesson 1.50 that simulates a Language Pals session.
- **2.** Students conduct a **LANGUAGE PALS SESSION** with their overseas correspondent, with a native-speaking visitor to the class or with their instructor.
- **3.** Students engage in a **DEBRIEFING SESSION**.
