DAY 90

LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.8

CONTENT:

1. PHONICS 6

OVERVIEW: Lesson 2.8 involves learning the language's phonics system with particular emphasis given to vowels in combination. These combinations of vowels are highlighted in the readings found in lesson 2.8 – either regarding the Richardson family, the Creation account in Genesis or both.

ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Play the **SCRAMBLED LETTERS GAME** with your students.
- 2. After having **READ** through the first four sections of lesson 2.8 with your students, as a test of the students' phonics learning to this point and to highlight the sounds produced by vowels in combination, play the **PHONICS DICTATION GAME** with your students.
- 3. Have the students engage in **INDEPENDENT STUDY** and direct them to review the reading in part 5 in preparation for the oral summary they will give on Day 92 regarding the images found at the end of lesson 2.9.
- 4. Conduct an **ORAL PARTICIPATION** session on the last session but, rather than asking the students to retell the story from the images, to enable them to practice the use of interrogatives, make statements about the images and ask them to form the question that would have been asked to receive an answer such as the statement you made.
