LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.12

CONTENT:

1. CONJUGATION OF THE DAILY ROUTINE VERBS
2. NEW VOCABULARY – NOUNS ASSOCIATED WITH PREPARING FOR THE DAY

OVERVIEW: In lesson 2.12, the students learn the simple present conjugations of the daily routine verbs, review the gestures associated with those verbs, practice the daily routine verbs' conjugations and learn new vocabulary associated with preparing to face the day.

ACTIVITIES:

1. Perform a **REVIEW SEQUENCE** regarding the daily routine verbs' gestures and identities.
2. **READ** through the conjugations of the daily routine verbs in sections 1 and 2, pointing out irregularities or the use of reflexive pronouns.
3. In section 3, click on the black rectangles to play the sound file for the students and have them perform the corresponding **gestures**. Then, click on the mouse and reveal the gestures they should have performed.
4. **READ** through sections 4 through 6 with the students and then play the **LOST AND FOUND GAME** regarding the nouns presented in this section. It should be possible for you to bring to class a sample of each of the items found in these sections, with the exception of the bathtub and shower. For those two, you may want to bring a photo mounted on sturdy cardboard.
